



Jennings County 911 maintains both a Facebook Page and a Twitter Account. National Weather Service Watches and Warnings are posted automatically and immediately to both sites as they are issued. Watches and Warnings for Tornados, Severe Thunderstorms, Flooding, and other Severe Weather will be posted.

Occasionally other public safety related information may be posted such as road conditions, road closures, school closings, and other announcements.


There is *no fee* to sign up and text messaging rates as set by your cell phone plan may apply.

We recommend using several methods to stay informed of severe weather including TV/Radio, NOAA Weather Radio, and Outdoor Community Sirens. If you want to be informed there are plenty of ways to be informed. It is also good to update your severe weather plan. What follows are instructions to begin receiving emergency alerts from us in the form of text messages on your cell phone.

FAST FOLLOW JENNINGS COUNTY 911 (*easiest method*)

1. Text **follow jce911** to number **40404**.
2. To stop this service at any time text the word **OFF** to **40404** and **ON** to turn it back on.



← You will receive this message first indicating you are signed up correctly.

You will also receive the most recent message from us that most likely will not be current and should also be ignored.

← You will receive this message asking you if you want to join Twitter – **YOU DO NOT NEED TO DO THIS – IGNORE IT!**

← You will receive a message similar to this. You *must* reply to this message **Set Discover Off** as it states in this message or you will get random messages asking you to follow other agencies on Twitter.

You should be all set to receive weather alerts and other critical public safety alerts on your cell phone! That's it! That's all you have to do!

Although our Facebook and Twitter pages are good ways to stay informed of severe weather, individuals should also have other means of being alerted to severe weather. These should include a NOAA weather radio, local radio and TV, as well as other means available.

Families should also have a severe weather plan that they practice routinely in the event of severe weather that includes their safe place of shelter.
